ORDER TO SHOW COMPLIANCE

The Missouri Public Service Commission is ordering the applicant to show compliance with certain Commission regulations. Commission regulation 4 CSR 240-2.010(13) provides that the application is a pleading:

Pleading means any application . . .

to which Commission regulation 4 CSR 240-2.080(6) applies:

By signing a pleading, the signer represents . . . that the signer is a licensed attorney at law in good standing in Missouri or has complied with the rules below concerning any attorney who is not a Missouri attorney [.]

The referenced “rules below” include Commission regulation 4 CSR 240-2.040(3):

Attorneys who wish to practice before the commission shall fully comply with its rules and also comply with one (1) of the following criteria [.]

The application bears the signature of applicant's “Counsel,” who does not appear in the Missouri Bar’s online official directory of licensed Missouri attorneys. Therefore, the Commission will require a showing of compliance with 4 CSR 240-2.080(6) and 4 CSR 240-2.040(3).

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than January 10, 2011, the applicant shall file a response to this order showing that the application complies with 4 CSR 240-2.080(6) and 4 CSR 240-2.040(3).
2. Such response may constitute an Attachment E to the application.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
