Commission will require a showing of compliance with 4 CSR 240-2.080(6)

and 4 CSR 240-2.040(3).

1. No later than January 10, 2011, the applicant shall file a response to this order

showing that the application complies with 4 CSR 240-2.080(6) and 4 CSR 240-2.040(3).
