STAFF REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME


COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation, states as follows:

1. On February 18, 2011, True Wireless, L.L.C. (“the Company”), a wireless carrier, filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (“ETC”) for the purpose of receiving federal universal service fund support for low income customers through Lifeline and LinkUp programs.

2. The Commission's March 10 Order required that the Staff file a recommendation on or before today, April 11. However, the Application remains deficient. The Company and the Staff agree that an extension would be reasonable so that the Company can address those deficiencies. The Staff requests that it be given an extension of time until April 25, 2011, or until five business days following the completion of the Application, whichever is later, to complete its review and make its recommendation.

WHEREFORE, the Staff requests that the Commission grant the Staff an additional ten days to complete its review of the Company's Response, until April 25, 2011, or until five business days following the completion of the Application, whichever is later.
