ORDER GRANTING STAFF REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On October 26, 2011¹, Chariton Valley Telecom Corporation (CV Telecom) applied for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) throughout the exchange of Macon, Missouri served by Spectra Communication Group, LLP. The Commission ordered its Staff to file a Recommendation no later than November 28.

On November 23, Staff filed its Request for Extension of Time. Staff explains that CV Telecom has data requests outstanding, the answers to which are not due until November 30. Thus, Staff asks for an Extension of Time until December 28 to file its Recommendation.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff Request for Extension of Time is granted.
2. The Staff of the Commission shall file its Recommendation no later than December 28, 2011.
