On March 23, 2007, Gregory Miller, purportedly on behalf of either American CLEC, and/or Globetel, Inc., purported to file an interconnection agreement with the Commission. Mr. Miller does not claim to be an attorney.

Among other deficiencies, the applicant is not represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Missouri. The Commission will close this case and, upon receiving a compliant application, will open a new case.

1. The above-captioned case is closed due its failure to comply with the above-referenced Commission rules.
