STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

1. On April 27, 2000, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an Order granting to Reitz Rentals, Inc., d/b/a SouthWest TeleConnect (SouthWest) a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services. On May 1, 2000, SouthWest filed its Basic Local Service Tariff. The tariff was filed with a 45-day effective date of June 15, 2000. On June 5, 2000, SouthWest extended the effective date of the tariff to June 25, 2000.

2. In the attached Memorandum, which is label Appendix A, the Staff states that the proposed tariff conforms to the Commission's Order granting certification, and recommends that SouthWest's proposed original Basic Local Telecommunications Services P.S.C. MO. Tariff No. 1 be approved.

On May 01, 2000, **Reitz Rentals, Inc., d/b/a SouthWest TeleConnect** (SWTC), a competitive telecommunications company, submitted an original **Basic Local Telecommunications Services P.S.C. MO. Tariff No. 1** (tariff) to the Public Service Commission (Commission) pursuant to its **Order Granting Certificate to Provide Basic Local Telecommunications Services** of April 27, 2000 (Order). SWTC filed its proposed telecommunications tariff with a 45-day effective date of June 15, 2000. On May 15, 2000, the Commission issued an **Order Directing Filing**, in which the Staff of the Commission was directed to issue its Recommendation regarding the proposed tariff not later than ten (10) working days prior to the proposed Effective Date of the tariff.

Corrections to texts required the submission of replacement versions of Original Pages 9, 12, 13, 17 through 20, and 23 on May 25, 2000. Clarification of text required the submission of a replacement version of Original Pages 6 and 24 on May 31, 2000. Further corrections required replacement Original Pages 13 through 16, 18, 22, 24 and 27, received on June 06, 2000. Time to process page corrections required a request to extend the Effective Date from June 15 to June 17, received on May 31, and then to June 25, received on June 05, 2000.

I. Background

On April 27, 2000, the Commission issued the **Order** effective May 09, 2000, in **Case No. TA-2000-396** granting a Certificate of Service Authority to SWTC to provide basic local telecommunications services in Missouri. The Commission granted a waiver of the requirement to file a tariff with the certification application per 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H), and ordered SWTC to file tariff sheets within 30 days after Commission approval of the necessary interconnection agreement with the appropriate Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier (ILEC). The Certificate of Service Authority is to become





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effective upon the effective date of the tariff. The Order required SWTC, as the Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC), to provide a written disclosure of all resale or interconnection agreements it had concluded, and explanations for the absence of any interconnection agreements, affecting its Missouri service areas.

A Stipulation and Agreement filed on April 10, 2000, was attached to the Order granting certification as Attachment 1, in which SWTC agreed to:

- File a written disclosure of all resale or interconnection agreements that will affect its intended Missouri service areas upon submission of its initial tariff.
- File its initial tariff within thirty (30) days of the effective date of the Commission's approval of a resale or interconnection agreement, and notify all affected parties at that time.
- Set its originating and terminating access rates not to exceed those lowest such rates of the underlying ILEC. As a reseller CLEC, SWTC's basic local tariff does not offer switched access services.

On May 02, 2000, SWTC filed a Notice and Disclosure that it had filed its tariff and notified concerned parties of its Resale Agreements. SWTC's proposed tariff will offer services in exchanges currently served by the incumbent Local Exchange Carriers (LECs) Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) and Sprint Missouri, Inc. (Sprint).

II. Interconnection Agreement

On March 17, 2000, the Commission issued an Order Approving Interconnection Agreement (Agreement) between SWTC and SWBT in Case No. TO-2000-426. On April 04, 2000, SWTC filed an Interconnection Agreement between SWTC and Sprint under Case No. TO-2000-621. The Commission approved the Interconnection Agreement with Sprint on May 31, 2000. As of this writing, no additional interconnection agreements have been completed.
