WITHDRAWAL OF TESTIMONY BY RESPONDENTS T-MOBILE USA, INC., AND WESTERN WIRELESS CORPORATION

Come now Respondents T-Mobile USA, Inc., and Western Wireless Corporation, and hereby withdraw the testimony which they filed in this docket on January 9, 2004. In support of this withdrawal, Respondents state the following:

1. In its Order of October 23, 2003, adopting the procedural schedule, the Commission stated that direct testimony had to be filed on or before January 9, 2004. There was no stated requirement that only Complainants would file direct testimony.

2. Upon the filing and service of the testimony of Ron Williams for Western Wireless and Lee Goldstein for T-Mobile, several parties questioned whether it would be more appropriate for this testimony to be filed as rebuttal testimony (which under the procedural schedule does not have to be filed until February 20, 2004).

3. Rather than confuse the record and the positions of the parties, T-Mobile and Western Wireless have elected to withdraw the pre-filed testimony of the witnesses mentioned

above, and will file testimony from those witnesses on or before the deadline for rebuttal testimony. Based upon consultation with counsel for many of the parties, including counsel for Complainants, this withdrawal should keep the record "clean" for purposes of the alignment of the parties.

4. If the Commission believes it must grant leave to Respondents to withdraw their testimony, the Respondents hereby make a motion for leave to withdraw the testimony, for the reasons set forth herein.

Wherefore, T-Mobile USA, Inc., and Western Wireless Corporation, inform and notify the Commission and the parties that the testimony of Ron Williams and Lee Goldstein is hereby withdrawn.
