MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR, IN THE ALTERNATIVE, MOTION FOR ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

Comes now CenturyTel Fiber Company II LLC ("CenturyTel Fiber"), by its undersigned attorneys, and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.160, moves for reconsideration of the Commission's Order of July 14, 2005, or, in the alternative, for an Order Nunc Pro Tunc, adding CenturyTel Fiber to the list of telecommunications carriers whose interconnection agreements with SBC are amended to extend their expiration date to August 10, 2005. In support of this Motion, CenturyTel Fiber states the following:

- 1. CenturyTel Fiber is the successor to Digital Teleport, Inc. ("DTI") in an M2A interconnection agreement with SBC. As part of the DTI bankruptcy, and CenturyTel Fiber's acquisition of DTI's assets in bankruptcy, the M2A interconnection agreement then in place between DTI and SBC was assigned to CenturyTel Fiber. SBC has honored that assignment, and has in all respects dealt with CenturyTel Fiber as the legitimate successor to DTI in the interconnection agreement.
- 2. On July 13, 2005, CenturyTel Fiber's Senior Vice President and General Counsel received from SBC a notice concerning the selection of a successor to the M2A. A copy of that notice is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. As the notice indicates, CenturyTel Fiber is to make a selection of the M2A agreement it wishes to adopt to succeed the existing DTI-SBC agreement.
- 3. On July 14, one day later, the Commission issued its Order, extending the procedural schedule for filing conforming agreements in this proceeding. The Commission also

amended by interlineation the existing M2A agreements of many carriers, extending the expiration date of those agreements to and including August 10, 2005. Although a CenturyTel Fiber affiliate, CenturyTel Solutions LLC, has its own M2A interconnection agreement with SBC, and is listed among the carriers subject to this amendment by interlineation, CenturyTel Fiber is not so listed in the Commission's July 14, 2005 Order in this docket even though it is the successor-in-interest to DTI's M2A agreement with SBC.

4. By this Application, CenturyTel Fiber requests that the Commission reconsider its July 14 Order and include CenturyTel Fiber among the companies listed in paragraph 2 of the Ordered Section, or, in the alternative, CenturyTel Fiber requests that the Commission issue an Order Nunc Pro Tunc, finding that CenturyTel Fiber should be included among the listed companies. The Commission's preferred procedural mechanism is of no consequence to CenturyTel Fiber (hence this Application is stated in the alternative). CenturyTel Fiber simply wishes to protect itself and its customers, so it can continue to provide reliable service while it is considering its options as to the adoption of a successor M2A agreement.

Wherefore, CenturyTel Fiber requests that the Commission reconsider paragraph 2 of the Ordered Section of its July 14 Order, or, in the alternative, issue an Order Nunc Pro Tunc providing that (1) CenturyTel Fiber is included among the list of carriers whose M2A interconnection agreements with SBC are extended to and including August 10, 2005, and (2) that CenturyTel Fiber shall be included among those interested carriers with M2A interconnection agreements in any future Commission Orders or Notices.

Re: Selection of Successor M2A

This letter is to advise that you will soon need to make a selection of the M2A successor agreement under which you intend to operate beginning July 19, 2005.

As you are aware, the procedural schedule in the M2A successor arbitration (Case No. TO-2005-0336) called for the Missouri Public Service Commission ("MO PSC") to issue its award on July 6, 2005. Conforming agreements were then to be filed by the parties on July 13, 2005 and approved by the Commission on July 19, 2005.

Per the terms of our Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU"), CenturyTel Fiber Company II, LLC has 10 days from the date that the first M2A successor agreement is approved to choose which successor M2A agreement it intends to operate under on and after July 19, 2005 (termination date of the M2A). On the date that we file the conformed agreement with the Commission, SBC will post the filed agreements on CLEC Online to assist you in making a selection.

While it is possible that these procedural dates may be extended slightly, it is very important to adhere as close as possible to the schedule set by the MO PSC in the procedural order to ensure that the replacement agreements are put in place in a timely and orderly fashion.

For all CLECs with a current M2A agreement and that are not a party to the Arbitration, we will therefore need you to make your M2A successor agreement selection by printing your specific short form located on CLEC Online (detailed instructions will be provided online), make your Agreement Case No. and Intercarrier Compensation selections, sign and fax to SBC (fax no. 1-800-404-4548) no later than ten days after the Commission approves the M2A successor agreements. (It is our understanding that the Commission intends to assign a specific case number to each arbitrated agreement and approve them all at one time.) If your signed selection is not received by SBC within that ten day period, then per the terms of the MOU, you will be deemed to have chosen the first successor M2A approved by the Missouri Commission.

SBC will return a copy of the executed signature page to you for your records. SBC will file the short form of the parties under the terms of 4 CSR 240-3.513. Where no signature page has been received, SBC will file under subpart (b) of that same rule.
