On June 5, 2013, the Commission issued an order granting AT&T Missouri's motion to dismiss the complaint brought against that company by a group of payphone service providers. That order became effective on July 5. On July 3, the Complainants filed a timely application for rehearing. AT&T Missouri responded in opposition to that application for rehearing on July 15.


Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." In the judgment of the Commission, the Complainants have not shown sufficient reason to rehear the order dismissing their complaint. The Commission will deny the application for rehearing.
