On February 11, 2013, the complainants filed a motion asking the Commission to further suspend its consideration of this complaint until the FCC acts. The complainants also ask the Commission to send a letter to the Chairman of the FCC urging the FCC to promptly resolve the case pending before it.

Before acting on the complainants' motion, the Commission will direct its Staff to respond to the motion to further suspend proceedings and the request that the Commission send a letter to the FCC. The Commission will also establish a date for the filing of any other responses to the complainants' motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall respond to Complainants' Request to Suspend Proceedings for an Additional 180 Days and for Other Commission Action no later than February 25, 2013.
2. Any other party wishing to respond to Complainants' Request to Suspend Proceedings for an Additional 180 Days and for Other Commission Action shall do so no later than February 25, 2013.
3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
