## **SECOND ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION AND DIRECTING STATUS REPORTS**

On April 11, 2011, the Commission's Staff requested an extension of time to file its recommendation. That extension was granted extending the deadline until April 25, 2011. On April 21, 2011, Staff requested a second extension of time. Staff states that it and True Wireless, L.L.C. agree that an extension of time is necessary so deficiencies in True Wireless' application can be addressed.

The Commission finds the request to be reasonable and will grant it. However, the request seeks an indefinite extension that would make Staff's recommendation due five business days following the completion of True Wireless' application. The parties are free to take as much time as is required, but the Commission will direct Staff to file monthly status reports.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The April 25, 2011 deadline for the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") to file a recommendation regarding True Wireless, L.L.C.'s application is canceled.

2. Staff shall file its recommendation five business days following the completion of True Wireless, L.L.C.'s application.

3. Staff shall file monthly status reports, due on the first business day of each month, until such time as Staff files its recommendation.

4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
