## REQUEST OF STOPAQUILA.ORG FOR PERMISSION TO PRESENT TESTIMONY OF HAROLD STANLEY, P.E., BY TELEPHONE AT HEARING

Mr. Harold Stanley, P.E., is on an outage at a power plant in New Mexico. The plant was powered down, and the engineers will be working intensely on the plant to renovate it over the next five weeks. Mr. Stanley will not be able to return to Missouri until approximately May 20. Under the present schedule, this return would be after the hearings are over. Stop Aquila would want to present his testimony. The affidavit of Mr. Stanley was filed last week. Aquila objected to the affidavit.

This motion may be premature and may be obviated by a deposition of Mr. Stanley that Aquila is now setting up. However, StopAquila files this motion so the PSC has time to consider this motion and rule on it so that in the event the testimony of Mr. Stanley at the hearing is needed by StopAquila, we would be permitted to present him by telephone.

Latitude should be given due to the extremely unusual nature of this proceeding and the expedited schedule. The parties have been forced to compress their schedules to accommodate Aquila.

StopAquila understands that if the deposition of Mr. Stanley is taken, the deposition would likely be presented by one or more parties, and there may be no need to have a ruling on this motion. At some point the parties may indicate that this motion does not need to be ruled upon.

StopAquila requests that the PSC permit the testimony of Harold Stanley by telephone at the PSC hearings.
