## ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION AND NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

On October 30, 2007, Embarq Missouri, Inc. filed an application for Approval of an Interconnection, Collocation & Resale Agreement. On October 31, 2007, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice and Making MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC a Party.

On November 1, 2007, Embarq filed a Motion to withdraw its October 30 Application because it inadvertently filed the application when it intended to file a letter requesting the adoption of a previously adopted interconnection agreement. Within the same filing, Embarq filed said letter requesting approval of a previously approved interconnection agreement between Embarq and AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. As such, its letter of application is deficient in that it appears Embarq neglected to attach the signature page signed by both parties to the adoption, as required by 4 CSR 240-3.513(4)(A).

To redress this deficiency, Embarq must provide a copy of the signature page signed by both parties to the adoption. No action will be taken on said adoption of the interconnection agreement request until it is brought into compliance with all Commission regulatory requirements. If no action is taken in this case within ninety (90) days it may be dismissed.
