ORDER REJECTING FILING FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH COMMISSION REGULATIONS

On July 3, 2006, Jim R. Dry, vice president of Image Access, Inc. d/b/a New Phone ("New Phone") filed an application with the Commission for approval of a negotiated resale agreement between New Phone and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T"). Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.513(1)(A) requires that applications for approval of interconnection agreements arrived at through negotiation must comply with the filing requirements identified in 4 CSR 240-2.040, 4 CSR 240-2.060, and 4 CSR 240-2.080.

The cited regulations impose numerous requirements on any application filed with the Commission. New Phone's application does not comply with many of those requirements. In particular, 4 CSR 240-2.080(1) requires that every pleading filed with the Commission be signed by an attorney authorized to practice law in Missouri. New Phone's application is not signed by an attorney authorized to practice law in Missouri and must be rejected.

If New Phone wishes to appropriately resubmit its application, it may do so in this case.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Image Access, Inc. d/b/a New Phone's application for approval of a negotiated resale agreement between New Phone and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a AT&T Missouri is rejected for failure to comply with applicable filing requirements.
 - 2. This order shall become effective on July 6, 2006.
