APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY
AND FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION

NOW COMES Steve's Wildcat Web, Inc. ("Wildcat" or "Applicant") by and through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to sections 392.361, 392.410, 392.420, 392.430 and 392.450, RSMo, the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, and 4 CSR 240-2.060 and 4 CSR 240-3.510, and hereby requests authority to provide basic local telecommunications service in portions of the State of Missouri and to classify Applicant and said service as competitive.

In support of its Application, Applicant states as follows:

1. Applicant Steve's Wildcat Web, Inc. is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Missouri with its principal place of business at: 330 Green Street, Brookfield, MO 64628. The character of business performed by Applicant is telecommunications services. A copy of Applicant's Certificate of Incorporation from the Missouri Secretary of State, as required by 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(C), is attached to this Application as **Exhibit A**.

3. By this Application, Applicant seeks authority to offer and provide basic local telecommunications service on a facilities-based and resold basis to customers in the Brookfield, Chillicothe and Marceline exchanges currently served by Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri (SBC), formerly known as Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), and the Laclede, Mendon and Rothville exchanges currently served by ALLTEL Missouri, Inc., d/b/a ALLTEL.

4. Applicant proposes to offer and provide all forms of basic local telecommunications service, including (but not limited to): (1) Basic Exchange Services, including local exchange flat rate, measured rate service, pre-paid local exchange, operator services, etc; (2) Custom and Class Features, including call waiting, caller ID, call forwarding, etc.; and (3) Ancillary Services such as 911, directory listing, and directory assistance.

5. Applicant possesses the technical and managerial expertise and experience necessary to provide the services it proposes as required by Section 392.455(1) RSMo Supp. 1997. In addition, the background and experience of Applicant's management is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**.

6. Applicant possesses the necessary financial qualifications to provide the services it proposes as required by Section 392.455(1) RSMo Supp. 1997 and has the necessary capital to conduct its proposed operations in Missouri. Applicant will late-file its pro forma financial statements as **Exhibit C**. Applicant is seeking a Protective Order from the Commission to enable it to file such statements under seal.

7. Pursuant to this Application, Applicant also seeks classification of itself and its new basic local telecommunications service offerings as competitive, with accompanying reduced regulation pursuant to Sections 392.361 RSMo and 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(A). Applicant believes that its proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation and that granting this request will allow greater price and service options for telephone users.

8. Applicant will offer basic local telecommunications service as a separate and distinct service in accordance with Section 392.455 RSMo. Applicant will give consideration to equitable access for all customers in Missouri, without regard to their income or where they might reside, to affordable telecommunications services in Applicant's proposed service

areas in accordance with Section 392.455(5) RSMo.

9. Applicant is willing to comply with all applicable Commission rules and is willing to meet all relevant service standards including, but not limited to, quality of service, billing, and tariff filing and maintenance. Consistent with the Commission's treatment of other certificated competitive local exchange telecommunications companies, Applicant requests that, at minimum, the following statutes and regulations for Applicant and its proposed basic local exchange service offerings be waived at this time:

10. Applicant requests a temporary waiver of 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(C), which requires that an application for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange, local exchange or basic local exchange service shall include a proposed tariff with a forty-five (45) day effective date. Applicant will promptly file a tariff with a 45-day effective date as soon as possible.

11. In any area served by ALLTEL, Applicant agrees to offer telecommunications services defined by the Commission as essential to qualify for state universal service fund

support (essential services) in 4 CSR 240-31.010(5), pursuant to Section 392.451.1(1).

12. In any area served by ALLTEL, Applicant agrees to advertise the availability of essential services and the charges for those services using media of general distribution in compliance with Section 392.451.1(2) RSMo.


13. Applicant herein states that there are no pending actions or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it in any state, federal agency, or court which involve customer service or rates for which action, judgment, or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application.

14. Applicant hereby affirms that the Company does not have any overdue annual reports or fees owed to the Missouri Public Service Commission.

15. Applicant submits that public interest will be served by Commission approval of this Application because Applicant's proposed services will create and enhance competition and expand customer service options, consistent with the legislative goals set forth in the Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo. Prompt approval of this Application also will expand the availability of innovative, high-quality and reliable telecommunications services within the State of Missouri.

WHEREFORE, Applicant Steve's Wildcat Web, Inc. respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service as herein requested, classify Applicant and its proposed services as competitive, and grant waivers of the aforesaid statutes and regulations.




