COME NOW Complainants and for their above entitled motion state the following to the Commission:

- 1. On March 1, 2005, the Commission entered an Order Acknowledging Filing of Status Report and Directing the Parties To File an Additional Status Report. In that order the parties were directed to file another joint status report on or before May 27, 2005.
- 2. Counsel for the parties have lacked opportunity to confer and hence have not been able to prepare a joint status report for the Commission.
