STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation respectfully states:

1. In the attached Memorandum, labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant approval of interconnection agreement between Embarq Missouri, Inc. and 1-800-Reconex (Agreement) filed by Embarq Missouri, Inc. under the provisions of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.

2. The terms of the Agreement do not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the Agreement and are not against the public interest, convenience or necessity. Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §252(e), the Commission is to approve a negotiated interconnection agreement unless the terms of the agreement discriminate against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement, or implementation of the agreement or any portion thereof is inconsistent with the public interest, convenience, or necessity.

3. Staff notes that 1-800-Reconex has not received authority from this Commission to use the fictitious name of U.S. Tel in Missouri. Staff has contacted 1-800-Reconex and Embarq Missouri, Inc. and understands that the parties to the Agreement have prepared an amendment to the interconnection agreement to address this situation, but have not yet submitted it to this case

file. Staff recommends approval of the Agreement subject to this amendment. Should the amendment not arrive prior to the time the Commission approves the Agreement, then Staff recommends that the Commission still approve the Agreement but clarify that its approval does not constitute approval for 1-800-Reconex to use the fictitious name U.S. Tel.

WHEREFORE, because the terms of the Agreement satisfy the standard set forth in 47 U.S.C. §252(e), Staff recommends the Commission approve the Agreement and direct the parties to submit any future modifications or amendments to the Agreement to the Commission for approval.


