APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

COMES NOW Southern Missouri Gas Company, L.P. ("SMGC") and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075 respectfully requests that the Commission grant SMGC the right to intervene in this proceeding. In support of this Application, SMGC states as follows:

1. On July 28, 1998, West Elm Place Corporation, The Empire District Electric Company, St. Joseph Light & Power Company, Arkansas Western Gas Company d/b/a Associated Natural Gas Company, Laclede Gas Company, Missouri-American Water Company and UtiliCorp United Inc. d/b/a Missouri Public Service (hereinafter "The Companies") filed an Application for Rehearing and Stay pursuant to Section 386.500, RSMo 1994¹, and 4 CSR 240-2.160, seeking rehearing regarding the Commission's June 29 Supplemental Order No. 52² ("Order 52") in Case No. 11,110. The Commission established Case No. OO-99-44 to address the Application for

² Order 52 is the order in which the Commission has set out its assessments of expenses directly attributable to all groups of public utilities and also the amounts of expenses not directly attributable to any such group. The purpose of Order 52 was to make the public utility assessments provided for, pursuant to Section 386.370, for the Commission's fiscal year commencing July 1, 1998 (the 1999 fiscal year or FY99).

Rehearing and Stay. The Companies have requested the Commission to reconsider its decision in this order.

2. In its Order Regarding Application for Rehearing and Stay issued on August 5, 1998, the Commission established an intervention deadline of August 31, 1998.

- 3. Southern Missouri Gas Company, L.P. is a public utility engaged in the distribution, transportation and sale of natural gas in southern Missouri. 5. Southern Missouri Gas Company, L.P. was assessed a regulatory assessment,

pursuant to Order 52. As a result, decisions in this proceeding potentially may affect the amount of

SMGC's regulatory assessment in 1999, and may potentially affect its regulatory assessment in
