- 3 JUDGE THOMPSON: Good morning. We are here in
- 4 the Matter of the Application of St. Louis County Water
- 5 Company, doing business as Missouri-American Water
- 6 Company, for Restatement and Clarification of its
- 7 Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for St. Louis
- 8 County, Missouri.
- 9 My name is Kevin Thompson. I am the
- 10 Regulatory Law Judge assigned to preside over this
- 11 matter.
- 12 At this time I will take oral entries of
- 13 appearance, beginning with the Company.
- 14 MR. CIOTTONE: Thank you, Your Honor. I am
- 15 Richard T. Ciottone of counsel with Brydon, Swearengen
- 16 and England. Their address is 312 East Capitol Avenue,
- 17 Jefferson City, Missouri. I'm appearing on behalf of
- 18 the Company.
- 19 JUDGE THOMPSON: Thank you, sir.

- 5 MR. PAPERNAR: I'm Howard Papernar. I am the
- 6 city attorney of Maryland Heights and Winchester in
- 7 St. Louis County, Missouri. Our address is

- 9 JUDGE THOMPSON: Thank you, sir.
- MR. PAPERNAR: Thank you.
- 11 JUDGE THOMPSON: Is anyone from the Public
- 12 Counsel here?

- 14 JUDGE THOMPSON: Let the record show that
- 15 Public Counsel is not present.
- 16 Do the parties have anything to bring to my
- 17 attention at this time?

- 19 JUDGE THOMPSON: Okay. Some of you, I
- 20 believe, are perhaps unfamiliar with our proceedings
- 21 here at the Commission. The purpose of this prehearing
- 22 conference -- what we call an early prehearing
- 23 conference is to bring the parties together so that you
- 24 will have an opportunity that you can use for
- 25 settlement discussions. That is the reason we do not

- 1 do these over the phone, or in other ways that would
- 2 not require you to be present together in a room.
- 3 You have this room from now until 5 p.m.
- 4 today, and you may pursue your discussions. Hopefully
- 5 they will be fruitful.
- 6 Pursuant to the order setting this conference,
- 7 there is due a week from today a proposed procedural
- 8 schedule. That schedule will include dates for an
- 9 evidentiary hearing for the filing of prepared
- 10 testimony pursuant to Commission rules; typically for a
- 11 later prehearing conference for the filing of a
- 12 Statement of Issues, for the filing of each parties'
- 13 position on each issue, as well as a list of witnesses
- 14 which will indicate the date that each witness will
- 15 appear, the order in which they're to be called and
- 16 also indicate the order of cross-examination with
- 17 respect to each witness. This is necessary because
- 18 there's usually more than two parties in one of our
- 19 proceedings.
- 20 It's also helpful if that last item also
- 21 includes the order of opening statements, although if
- 22 it does not, we can always work that out at the
- 23 beginning of the hearing.
- 24 There is a calendar which you may inspect
- 25 upstairs on the 9th floor in the adjudication

1	department so that you can see what dates are open for
2	the evidentiary hearing. Unfortunately we do not have
3	the calendar down here. It's not available down here,
4	and I apologize for that. I hope that that will be
5	it will be available down here soon.
6	Any questions at this time?

8	JUDGE THOMPSON: Hearing none, that will
9	conclude the on-the-record portion of the prehearing
10	conference, and I will leave you to your hopefully
11	fruitful discussions.
