ORDER DISMISSING PARTIES AND DIRECTING FILING

A conference on these matters was held on February 1, 2006, to ascertain what issues remained in controversy and which parties were still involved. In order to facilitate the orderly and expeditious resolution of these matters, this order is issued to clarify the present status of these matters.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That all parties to these matters except the Commission Staff, the Public Counsel, AT&T Missouri, T-Mobile, and the four Petitioners (Northeast Missouri Rural Telephone Company, Alma Telephone Company, Chariton Valley Telephone Corporation and Mid-Missouri Telephone Company) are dismissed from these cases, together with any and all claims raised with respect to their participation in these matters. All pending motions by such dismissed parties are denied and they are excused from any further participation in these matters.
- 2. That the remaining parties shall file the following on or before February 24, 2006:
 - A statement of the total minutes of use asserted to be uncompensated and subject to the compensation dispute in these matters. These minutes shall include all minutes, up to the present time, about which there is a compensation dispute;
 - A timeline that indicates whether, at the time the minutes of use occurred, there was in place an approved wireless traffic termination tariff, or interconnection agreement negotiation had been formally requested;
 - c. For Case No. TC-2002-57, under a single cover pleading filed in EFIS, a refiling of those pleadings or portions of pleadings that are presently relevant to the issues remaining in that matter; and
 - d. For Case No. TC-2002-57, under a single cover pleading filed in EFIS, a refiling of any testimony concerning the appropriate rate or rates to be charged for termination of the minutes of use in dispute in this matter.
- 3. That the pending and opposed Motion to Consolidate is neither granted nor denied at this time.

4. That this order shall become effective on February 1, 2006.
