The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its objection to the Motion for Expedited Treatment of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri. Staff indicated that it needed more time to review the proposed modification than the expedited request would allow. Staff did not, however, state how much time it would need or when it expects to be able to file a recommendation. Therefore, the Commission shall direct Staff to make such a filing.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. No later than October 23, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a pleading stating how much time it needs to evaluate the proposed modification of the intraLATA toll dialing plan and when it expects to file its recommendation.

2. This order shall become effective on October 18, 2007.
