STAFF'S STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its status report states:

- 1. On October 4, 2007, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed a motion requesting that the Commission approve a modification of its intraLATA Toll Dialing Plan (ILDP). AT&T Missouri requests elimination of the intraLATA equal access scripting requirement. In addition, AT&T Missouri requested that the Commission make its decision in this matter no later than October 31, 2007.
- 2. On October 11, 2007, the Commission directed the Staff to respond no later than October 15 to AT&T Missouri's motion for expedited treatment and to respond, no later than October 18 to request for modification or to indicate the earliest possible date on which it intends to file its response.
- 3. On October 15, the Staff filed its response in opposition to AT&T Missouri's motion for expedited treatment.
- 4. On October 17, the Staff submitted data requests to AT&T Missouri. AT&T Missouri promptly provided verbal response on the same day. The Staff expects to file its recommendation in this matter no later than October 23, 2007.
