

AmerenUE and Callaway Electric Cooperative are considering agreements to exchange some electric distribution facilities and to define exclusive service areas. AmerenUE and Callaway Electric Cooperative believe that these agreements would enable both utilities to operate more efficiently by eliminating costly duplication of service, help to keep rates down, improve service, and provide for orderly growth in the area. 


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
