On March 24, 2005, Matrix Telecom, Inc., Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc., Global Crossing Local Services, Inc., and Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc., filed an application requesting approval of a transaction in which Matrix would acquire certain assets of the Global Crossing companies. The applicants requested approval by the Commission by May 15, 2005.

On April 1, 2005, the Commission's Staff filed its Status Report, noting that because Matrix does not have a certificate of service authority to provide customers with basic local telecommunications service, the Staff is unable to state a specific date on which it will be able to file its recommendation. Staff also indicates that it anticipates that Matrix will soon file an application for authority to provide basic local telecommunications service.

The Commission will direct Staff to file a second status report regarding the progress in this case and any related application case. The Commission also notes that, effective May 18, 2005, this case has been reassigned from Judge Lewis Mills to Judge Vicky Ruth.
