EXAMINER O'DONNELL: This prehearing conference is called to order.

The Commission has set this prehearing conference at this time in the case of TA-88-218, et al., which is concerning alternative operator services.

At this time lets go ahead and entertain oral entries of appearance beginning with the applicants.

MR. JOHNSON: Mark P. Johnson on behalf of American Operator Services, Incorporated.

MR. BROWNLEE: Richard Brownlee, the law firm of Hendren and Andrae, 235 East High Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, on behalf of applicants ITI, Inc., and Teleconnect.

EXAMINER O'DONNELL: I guess that--if you want to go ahead with Staff's attorney next and Public Counsel and then the intervenors.

4 EXAMINER O'DONNELL: Public Counsel, did you
5 have another entry of appearance you wanted to make?

6 MR. WHEATLEY: Yes. Mark D. Wheatley, Post
7 Office Box 7800, Jefferson city, Missouri 65102, appearing
8 for the Office of the Public Counsel and the Public.

9 EXAMINER O'DONNELL: Has everyone then who
10 needs to made an oral entry of appearance?

11 MR. JOHNSON: I think I neglected to give
12 you my mailing address. Mark P. Johnson, Spencer, Fane,
13 Britt & Browne, 1000 Walnut, Suite 1400, Kansas City,
14 Missouri, 64106.

15 EXAMINER O'DONNELL: At this time I'd like
16 to address the application to intervene by Operator
17 Assistance Network, the attorney of which doesn't appear to
18 be here.

19 Public Counsel, did you have something you
20 wanted to say?

21 MS. OTT: Well, we would object to their
22 intervention at this late date primarily because they're
23 exactly--well, they're coming in on the side of the operator
24 services companies. We have a lot of questions about their
25 practices. I think one of our witnesses even referred to

1 that in her direct testimony.

2 It's my understanding that what OAN does is
3 they go around to local exchange companies and try to
4 negotiate billing and collection contracts for AOS providers
5 for a fee. It's our feeling that this is yet another
6 middleman in the process which causes the cost of AOS
7 services to go up to our clients, the end users.

8 But obviously we have no way of proving this
9 up if we can't conduct discovery of these people. So we
10 would just prefer--we think it's not really fair to let them
11 in at this late date so they can cross-examine our witnesses
12 and yet we know nothing about what they do or how they
13 operate.

14 EXAMINER O'DONNELL: Is there anyone else
15 who wants to address this late-filed intervention?

16 (No response.)

17 EXAMINER O'DONNELL: The Commission would
18 like to allow this late-filed intervention with the proviso
19 that they understand that they have to take the calendar as
20 it is, which would limit their contribution to the hearing.

21 At the same time, since they're not here at
22 the prehearing conference, you know, there begins to be a
23 question of the rules, whether or not that they would be
24 retained as a party. So I would say that at this point,
25 though, that their intervention is granted.

1 I'd like to also address the motion to
2 strike. Public Counsel has moved that the testimony of
3 Dennis Thomas, which is sponsored by ITI, be stricken in its
4 entirety as being direct testimony under the guise of
5 rebuttal testimony.

6 I believe that ITI has responded to this
7 motion and so I don't know of anyone else that really has
8 grounds to respond to it, so at this time I will address
9 that motion; and the motion is denied.

10 Are there any other matters we need to take
11 up before you begin?

12 Mr. Cadieux.

13 MR. CADIEUX: Your Honor, just as a matter
14 of clarification. I understand that when these cases were
15 consolidated, that the filings of Dial U.S. and Dial U.S.A.
16 were also--were included in this consolidated case. They
17 had separate case numbers and were included. I realize that
18 there hasn't been prepared testimony filed, and I did not
19 hear representation this morning. I guess my question is:
20 Are those tariff filings still part of this case or has it
21 somehow separated?

22 EXAMINER O'DONNELL: No, they have not been
23 separated.

24 Are there any other questions?
