STAFF RECOMMENDATION AND MOTION FOR LEAVE TO LATE FILE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation and motion states:

- 1. On October 5, 2007, Crossroads Wireless Holding, L.L.C. filed an application with the Commission for approval of an interconnection Agreement with AT&T Missouri under the provisions of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996. Crossroads states that there are no unresolved issues and that the agreement complies with Section 252(e) of the Act in that it is not discriminatory to nonparty carriers and is consistent with the public interest.
- 2. Section 252(e) of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 provides that a State commission may only reject a negotiated agreement (or any portion thereof) if it finds that the agreement (or any portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or if the implementation of the agreement (or portion) is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)
- 3. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff states that the amendments do not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the agreement and are not against the public interest, convenience or necessity.

4. It was not the Staff's intention to delay the filing of its recommendation in this case

and the brief delay in its filing should prejudice no party. The Staff apologizes for any

inconvenience this late-filing may have caused.

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully requests the Commission for leave to late-file its

recommendation, and recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission approve the

interconnection agreement pursuant to the Act, and direct the parties to submit any modifications

or amendments.
