#### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and submits its Recommendation as follows:

- 1. On June 18, 2018, CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, d/b/a CenturyLink ("CenturyLink") filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission an Application for Approval of the TELRIC Transport Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement executed between it and Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC ("Charter").
- 2. 47 USC 252(e)(2) provides that a state commission may only reject an interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation if the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to it or its implementation is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.
- 3. In lieu of a Memorandum, Staff hereby states that the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement does not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not parties to it, nor is its implementation inconsistent with the public interest, convenience or necessity. A copy of the Amendment was filed with the Application. CenturyLink is certificated with the Commission as an incumbent local exchange

telecommunications company. Charter is certificated as a competitive local exchange and interexchange telecommunications company.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends the Commission approve the Application and direct the parties to submit to the Commission any additional modifications or amendments to the Interconnection Agreement.
