STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation states:

- 1. On November 29, 2006, First Communications, LLC ("First"), Acceris Management and Acquisition LLC ("Acceris") and New Access Communications LLC ("New Access") (collectively, "Applicants") filed a joint application, pursuant to Section 392.300 RSMo and 4 CSR 240-3.520, requesting that the Commission grant them the authority necessary to consummate transactions involving the transfer of the assets and customers of Acceris and New Access to First. After consummation of the transactions, Acceris and New Access will cease operations in Missouri.
- 2. First has submitted tariff sheets (Tariff File No. YX-2007-0422) to amend its tariff to include the same services, rates, terms and conditions as in the existing Acceris and New Access tariffs for the customers being acquired by First.
- 3. In the attached Memorandum, labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends approval of the transfer. The transfer of assets is governed by Section 392.300 RSMo (2000). Applicable case law provides that the Commission may "not withhold its approval of the disposition of

assets unless it can be shown that such disposition is detrimental to the public interest." *State ex rel. Fee Fee Trunk Sewer, Inc. v. Litz*, 596 S.W. 2d 466, 468 (Mo. App. E.D. 1980), citing to *State ex rel.City of St. Louis v. Public Serv. Comm'n of Mo.*, 73 S.W. 2d 392, 400 (Mo. banc 1934).

4. Commission rules 4 CSR 240-3.520 (2) and 4 CSR 240-33.150(4) read together direct the Applicants to notify affected customers through a bill notice at least 30 days prior to their transfer to First.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission approve the transfer of assets and customers, approve First's tariff sheets effective January 19, 2007, direct the Applicants to notify customers at least 30 days prior to their transfer to First, and direct the Applicants to file a pleading after the transfer has been consummated so that the certificates and tariffs of Acceris and New Access may be cancelled.
