ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND TARIFF OF SBC ADVANCED SOLUTIONS, INC.

On September 25, 2008, the Commission issued an order approving the merger of SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Advanced Solutions, and AT&T Corp. The Commission directed AT&T Corp., the surviving entity, to file adoption notices and tariff title sheets adopting the tariffs of SBC Advanced Solutions currently on file with the Commission. In a related case, TA-2009-0045, AT&T Corp. applied for and was granted interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications service authority.

AT&T Corp. filed adoption notices and tariff sheets adopting SBC Advanced Solutions' tariffs for interexchange and nonswitched local exchange services on October 1, 2008. The tariff sheets became effective on October 31, 2008.

On November 5, 2008, AT&T Corp. notified the Commission that the merger with SBC Advanced Solutions was completed on October 31, 2008. The Commission will therefore cancel SBC Advanced Solutions' certificate of service authority and tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate of service authority to provide interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services, granted to SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc.

(thereafter, SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Advanced Solutions), on November 8, 1999, in Case No. TA-2000-260, is canceled.

- 2. Tariff No. YX-2006-0586 of SBC Advanced Solutions, d/b/a AT&T Advanced Solutions, is canceled.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on November 17, 2008.
 - 4. This case may close on November 18, 2008.
