## **MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE**

COMES NOW YMax Communications Corp. ("YMax"), by and through its attorney of record, and moves the Commission to continue the Prehearing Conference and the deadline for filing a Procedural Schedule currently set in this matter. In support of its Motion, YMax states the following:

- 1. On July 10, 2012<sup>1</sup>, YMax Communications Corp. filed tariff revisions, later substituted on July 31, 2012. The tariff sheets bore an effective date of August 10, 2012.
- 2. On August 3, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. ("AT&T Communications") and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri") filed a *Motion to Suspend and Investigate Tariff*.
- 3. On August 7, the Commission Staff filed its *Recommendation to Suspend Tariff.* In its filing, Staff recommended a 60-day suspension and stated, "If the matter can be resolved more quickly, the Staff will, in its recommendation to approve the filing, ask that the suspension be lifted and the tariff made effective on a certain date. If the 60-day period is not sufficient, the Staff will request a further suspension."

- 4. On August 8, the Commission issued its *Order Suspending Tariff and Scheduling Prehearing Conference* in this matter. That Order suspended the proposed tariff revisions until October 9, set a Prehearing Conference for August 22, and set a deadline of August 29 for the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule.
- 5. On August 13, MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services ("Verizon") filed its Motion to Intervene. On August 7, Verizon had filed a Request for Leave to File Comments.
- 6. On August 16, undersigned counsel filed his Entry of Appearance on behalf of YMax in this matter.
- 7. YMax has filed the tariff revisions at issue here in order to comply with new requirements imposed by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"). YMax believes additional time before a formal Prehearing Conference could be beneficial to the parties to informally discuss the issues and seek possible resolution thereof.
- 8. YMax respectfully requests a continuance of the Prehearing Conference from August 22 until September 4, and an extension of the deadline for filing a procedural schedule from August 29 until September 11.
- 9. Counsel for YMax has discussed this Motion (via telephone and/or email) with all parties and there is no objection.

WHEREFORE, YMax Communications Corp. respectfully requests the Missouri Public Service Commission to continue the Prehearing Conference in this matter from August 22 until September 4, and to extend the deadline for filing a procedural schedule from August 29 until September 11.
