**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE 2003 ANNUAL REPORT**

COMES NOW Trigen-Kansas City Energy Corporation (“Trigen”), by and through counsel, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.015 and 4 CSR 240-3.015 (to the extent applicable), and for its Motion for Extension of Time to File 2003 Annual Report respectfully states as follows:

1. Trigen is in the process of adjusting certain of its records and accounts (such as its plants records and depreciation reserve accounts) and does not anticipate completion of such adjustments in time for filing its 2003 Annual Report by April 15, 2004. This work is continuing, but completion of the adjustments has been delayed due in part to changes and reductions in Trigen’s staff.

2. 4 CSR 240-10.080(8) and 4 CSR 240-2.015 (to the extent applicable) allow a utility to request an extension of time within which to file the annual report, provided the reasons therefor are stated. At this time, Trigen believes it will need thirty (30) days beyond April 15, 2004 to file its annual report. Trigen submits that the Commission should find good cause exists to grant it until May 15, 2004 to file its annual report.

WHEREFORE, Trigen respectfully moves the Commission to grant this Motion for Extension of Time to File 2003 Annual Report and requests the Commission issue an order which grants Trigen until May 15, 2004 to file its annual report.
