**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME**  
**AND FURTHER SUSPENDING TARIFF**

On November 28, 2007, Level 3 Communications, L.L.C., filed a motion for additional time to either resolve the issues in this matter or to propose a procedural schedule. Level 3 relates that significant progress toward resolution of this matter has occurred; however, the parties need additional time to finalize the tariff revisions and procedural matters. Level 3 requests additional time, to December 6, 2007, to either resolve the issues or propose a procedural schedule, and consents to further suspension of the effective date of the tariff to December 14, 2007. Level 3 states that Staff, the AT&T Companies and the Office of the Public Counsel have no objection to this request.

The Commission has considered the motion and finds it to be reasonable. Therefore, the Commission shall grant Level 3's motion for additional time and shall further suspend the tariff sheets from December 7, 2007, to December 14, 2007.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Level 3 Communications, L.L.C.'s Motion for Additional Time and Further Suspension of Tariff is granted.

2. No later than December 6, 2007, the parties shall file either a proposed procedural schedule or a status report or other pleading regarding resolution of the issues in this case.

3. The proposed tariff sheets, Tariff No. JC-2008-0133, are further suspended until December 14, 2007.

4. This order shall become effective on December 7, 2007.
