MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves that the Commission cancel Telaleasing Enterprises, Inc.'s (Telaleasing) certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone services in Missouri. In support of its Motion, Staff respectfully states as follows:

1. On December 13, 1988, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an order granting a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone services, to Telaleasing Enterprises, in Case No. TA-89-82.

2. On September 30, 2007, the Chief Financial Officer of Telaleasing sent a letter to the Commission, requesting that the Commission eliminate the registration of Telaleasing. (The Commission received this letter on March 7, 2008, a true and accurate copy of the letter is attached hereto as Attachment A).

3. The letter indicated that Telaleasing no longer operates private coin phones in Missouri.

4. The services to be discontinued are private pay telephone services.

5. Telaleasing has no past due annual reports or assessments to the Commission.

6. Telaleasing is reflected as being in good standing by the Missouri Secretary of State's website.

7. Because Telaleasing has requested to be eliminated from registration, effectively a request to cancel its certificate, and because it is not providing private pay telephone service in Missouri, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order canceling the company's certificate.

8. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo (Supp. 2006), which provides:

"Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority of Telaleasing Enterprises, Inc. to provide private pay telephone services in Missouri.
