SURVEILLANCE REPORT

On August 15, 2000, the Commission issued an order that approved Le-Ru Telephone Company's financing request. One provision in that order required Le-Ru to file semiannual surveillance reports beginning January 1, 2003, and ending December 31, 2007, or when the company's equity ratio reaches 40 percent. Le-Ru has not yet filed its surveillance report for the period ending December 31, 2007. Therefore, the Commission will direct Le-Ru to expeditiously file the required report.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Le-Ru Telephone Company shall file its semiannual surveillance report no later than April 22, 2008.

2. This order shall become effective on April 1, 2008.
