## MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TARIFF EFFECTIVE DATE

COMES NOW YMax Communications Corp. ("YMax"), by and through its attorney of record, and moves the Commission to extend the effective date of the pending revised tariffs in this matter for two (2) weeks, until October 23, 2012. In support of its Motion, YMax states the following:

- 1. On July 10, 2012<sup>1</sup>, YMax Communications Corp. filed tariff revisions, later substituted on July 31, 2012. The tariff sheets bore an effective date of August 10, 2012.
- 2. On August 3, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. ("AT&T Communications") and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri") filed a *Motion to Suspend and Investigate Tariff*.
- 3. On August 7, the Commission Staff filed its *Recommendation to Suspend Tariff*.
- 4. On August 8, the Commission issued its *Order Suspending Tariff and Scheduling Prehearing Conference* in this matter. That Order suspended the proposed tariff revisions until October 9, set a Prehearing Conference for August 22, and set a deadline of August 29 for the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule.

- 5. On August 13, MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services ("Verizon") filed its Motion to Intervene. On August 7, Verizon had filed a Request for Leave to File Comments.
- 6. On August 16, undersigned counsel filed his Entry of Appearance on behalf of YMax in this matter.
- 7. On August 17 and August 31, the Commission continued the Prehearing Conference in this matter to facilitate discussions among the partes.
- 8. On September 9, YMax filed two substitute tariff pages.
- 9. On September 10, AT&T withdrew its objections to the tariffs in this matter, Verizon withdrew its motion for leave to intervene and the Commission cancelled the prehearing conference.
- 10. In order to provide additional time for Staff to review the proposed tariffs, as revised and substituted, in this matter and to develop its recommendation to the Commission, YMax respectfully requests that the Commission extend the effective date of the proposed tariff sheets for two (2) weeks, from October 9 until October 23.
- 11. Counsel for YMax has discussed this Motion (via telephone and/or email) with all parties and there is no objection.

WHEREFORE, YMax Communications Corp. respectfully requests the Missouri Public Service Commission to extend the effective date of the proposed tariff sheets for two (2) weeks, from October 9 until October 23.
