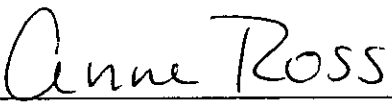

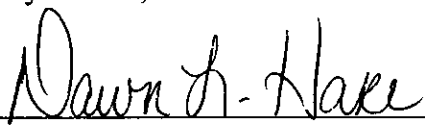

Q. Please state your name and business address.

A. My name is Anne Ross and my business address is Missouri Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65102.

Q. What is your present position with the Missouri Public Service Commission?

A. I am a Regulatory Economist in the Energy Department of the Operations Division.

Q. Would you please review your educational background?

A. I have a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration and an M.B.A. from the University of Missouri - Columbia.

Q. Have you previously filed testimony before the Commission?

A. Yes. I joined the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) in September, 1989. Since that time, I have filed testimony on class cost-of-service and rate design in a number of natural gas and electric cases.

Q. What is the purpose of your surrebuttal testimony?

A. The purpose of my testimony is to address the portion of Union Electric Company witness Warner L. Baxter's rebuttal testimony on pages 21 and 22 that draws conclusions regarding the reasonableness of AmerenUE's rates based on rate comparisons or

1 statements of other individuals or entities. I will describe the preparation of an average
2 revenue per kilowatt-hour comparison report that I compile annually and distribute to the
3 Commissioners and Staff. Schedule 1-1 is the cover memorandum that I send out with this
4 report and in particular it is the cover memorandum that I used for the most recent report on
5 February 25, 2002.

6 Q. What is the purpose of this report?

7 A. This report summarizes dollars per kilowatt hour information for the electric
8 and natural gas industries for the 50 states and the District of Columbia, and is intended to be
9 used for informational purposes.

10 Q. What is the source of the information used in this report?

11 A. My report uses information published annually by the Energy Information
12 Administration (EIA), Electric Power Division, Office of Coal, Nuclear, Electric and
13 Alternate Fuels, U.S. Department of Energy. The EIA is identified in this publication as the
14 independent statistical and analytical agency within the Department of Energy. For the most
15 recent electric industry report that I compiled information for and sent to the Commissioners
16 and Staff, I used the EIA publication Electric Sales and Revenue 2000, published
17 January 2002.

18 Q. What Missouri information do you compile from this publication for the
19 electric industry section of your report?

20 A. The report that I compiled contains Missouri-specific information on all
21 investor-owned, cooperative, and municipal electric utilities in Missouri, including customer
22 numbers, revenue, sales and dollars per kilowatt-hour. This information is grouped
23 according to the broad Standard Industry Classification (SIC) code groupings of Residential,

1 Commercial, and Industrial, as well as calculated for each utility in total. Schedule 1-7 is a
2 representative page from the report that I distribute. Schedule 1-7, among other things,
3 shows information respecting Missouri investor-owned electric utilities.

4 Q. Does the information that you compiled from the EIA publication differ from
5 the conclusions stated in Mr. Baxter's testimony?

6 A. I have provided this information to Staff witness Robert E. Schallenberg. He
7 will address this question in his surrebuttal testimony.

8 Q. Does this conclude your surrebuttal testimony?

9 A. Yes, it does.

The Energy Information Administration (EIA) publishes annual reports regarding natural gas and electric customer numbers, usage and revenue for each state. These reports are the Natural Gas Annual 2000, and the Electric Sales and Revenue 2000.

I have organized this information as follows:

Attachment A: 1995-2000 electric information for all 50 states and the District of Columbia regarding overall, residential, commercial, and industrial customer dollars per kilowatt-hour, along with 1995-2000 rankings for these four groupings, based on dollars/kilowatt-hour.

Attachment B: 2000 electric information for all 50 states and the District of Columbia regarding overall, residential, commercial, and industrial customer dollars per kilowatt-hour. Rankings are calculated for these four groupings, based on dollars/kilowatt-hour.

Attachment C: 2000 information on Missouri electric investor-owned, cooperative, and municipal electric companies. Customer numbers, revenue, sales, and dollars per kilowatt-hour are provided for residential, commercial, and industrial customers.

Attachment D: 1995-2000 natural gas information for all 50 states and the District of Columbia regarding residential, commercial, industrial, vehicle fuel, and electric utility customer dollars per Mcf, along with 1995-2000 rankings for these five groupings, based on dollars/Mcf.

Attachment E: 2000 natural gas information for all 50 states and the District of Columbia. Customer numbers, deliveries, average consumption and average delivered price are provided for residential, commercial, and industrial customers. Deliveries and average delivered price are provided for vehicle fuel and electric utility customers. Rankings are calculated for these five groupings, based on average delivered price.
