## ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On November 15, 2012, 360networks (USA) inc. ("360networks") filed an application requesting their certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide basic local exchange, non-switched local exchange and interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. 360networks also requested any approved tariff be cancelled. The Commission granted 360networks a certificate of service authority to provide telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Number TO-2001-99.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.

The Commission will direct its Staff to review the request and file a recommendation regarding the cancellation of 360networks' certificate of service authority and accompanying tariffs.

- 2. No later than November 28, 2012, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file with the Commission a recommendation regarding 360networks (USA) inc.'s request to cancel its certificates of service authority and accompanying tariff.
  - 3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
