ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

Effective Date: June 29, 2015

On June 3, 2015, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Daniel J. Ham (“Mr. Ham”) certificate of service authority to provide private pay telecommunication services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TA-95-199, the Commission granted Mr. Ham a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telecommunication service in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that Mr. Ham contacted Staff via Mr. Ham’s Statement of Revenue for the FY-2016 Mo PSC Assessment stating Mr. Ham was no longer wished to retain the certificate to provide service in Missouri and requested the Commission cancel Mr. Ham’s certificate of service authority. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company’s certificate of service authority to provide private pay telecommunications services.

On June 4, 2015, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than June 15, 2015. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.


The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Daniel J. Ham, shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate of authority to provide private pay telecommunications services granted to Daniel J. Ham, in File Number TA-95-199, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on June 29, 2015.
3. This case may be closed on June 30, 2015.
