On January 5, 2011, the Staff of the Commission filed a pleading entitled Request for Notice of Ineffective Tariff Revision. That pleading explains that MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services filed a tariff revision on December 28, 2010. That tariff, to which the Commission assigned tariff file number JL-2011-0327, proposes to revise the company's Local Voice – PRI/T1 Flat Rate Plan, and carries a January 1, 2011 effective date. Staff contends the tariff filing contains "text changes" that can only be made by filing a tariff with a 30-day effective date. For that reason, Staff asks the Commission to issue a notice advising Verizon "the tariff filing is not effective by operation of law and will not become effective unless it is submitted with a 30-day effective date."

Before it takes any action regarding Verizon's tariff, the Commission will give the company an opportunity to respond. If Verizon responds by filing a tariff with a 30-day effective date, no other response is necessary.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services, shall respond to Staff's Request for Notice of Ineffective Tariff Revision no later than February 4, 2011.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
