On January 17, 2012, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to reject a tariff filing made on January 17 by Comcast Phone of Missouri, LLC, d/b/a CIMCO, a Division of Comcast Business Services. Staff does not take issue with the substance of Comcast's tariff. Rather, Staff is concerned that Comcast purports to make its tariff revision effective on January 19, instead of allowing the thirty-days notice of such tariff revisions required by Section 392.220.2, RSMo (Supp. 2010). Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.545(18) provides that the Commission will not accept for filing a tariff that does not comply with the statute's thirty-day notice requirement. Therefore, the Commission will reject Comcast's tariff filing. Comcast is free to refile its proposed tariff revision with the required thirty-day notice.
