Motion for Temporary Restraining Order.

Complainant comes before the honorable Judge Clark and request the relief of a temporary restraining order against Ameren Missouri.

Ameren Missouri on June 15th, 2023, commenced in committing property damage to the premises [REDACTED], in which Ameren Missouri to date hasn't rectified or announced their plans to reimburse or pay for the damages their technicians caused to the property.

On July 6, 2023, furthered their harassment grounds in sending a technician to the premises to "check the meter" even though the meter is off and disconnected from the main pole, as they did on June 15th, 2023.

Ameren has been told numerous times to stop with their harassing methods, they've continued, despite many requests.

At this point if Ameren plans to continue trespassing and harassment in person, already knowing that services are off I believe that the recommendation the complainant prays for is the honorable Judge Clark to grant a temporary restraining order against Ameren Missouri for their continued harassment.

Whereas complainant prays that Judge Clark will grant a temporary restraining order against Ameren Missouri for continued harassment and trespassing.
