On October 9, 2007, Qwest Communications Corporation ("QCC") filed a verified Application for Approval of Corporate Restructuring with the Commission seeking the Commission's approval of two proposed internal corporate mergers whereby Phoenix Telecom, Inc. ("PTI") and Qwest Internet Solutions, Inc. ("QIS"), which were both whollyowned subsidiaries of QCC, would be merged into QCC, with QCC emerging as the surviving entity.
