ORDER CLOSING CASE

On October 9, 2007, Qwest Communications Corporation (“QCC”) filed a verified Application for Approval of Corporate Restructuring with the Commission seeking the Commission’s approval of two proposed internal corporate mergers whereby Phoenix Telecom, Inc. (“PTI”) and Qwest Internet Solutions, Inc. (“QIS”), which were both wholly-owned subsidiaries of QCC, would be merged into QCC, with QCC emerging as the surviving entity.

By order dated November 8, 2007, the Commission granted QCC's application, subject only to the following additional requirement: "Upon completion of the merger transactions described in the body of this order, Qwest Communications Corporation shall file an appropriate notice with the Commission and this case shall be closed." On January 9, 2008, QCC filed its Notice of Compliance with that order, explaining that effective December 31, 2007, the mergers were completed as approved by the Commission. Accordingly, this case will be closed.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. This case shall be closed on the effective date of this order.

2. This order shall become effective on January 10, 2008.
