## ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On April 23, 2013, Zayo Group, LLC (“Zayo”), successor in interest to American Fiber Systems, Inc. (“AFS”), (collectively, the “Company”) filed an application requesting the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to AFS to provide non-switched local exchange and interexchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Company also requested any approved tariff be cancelled. The Commission granted AFS a certificate of service authority to provide telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Number TA-2001-0258.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.

The Commission will direct its Staff to review the request and file a recommendation regarding the cancellation of AFS' certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any party wishing to file an objection or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than May 6, 2013, with:

2. No later than May 10, 2013, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file with the Commission a recommendation regarding the request to cancel the certificates of service authority and accompanying tariff of American Fiber Systems, Inc.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
