- 1. In this case, the parties notify the Commission of their desire to update their Superseding Amendment filed on September 15, 2004 by entering into a Further Amendment, signed by the parties in March and April of 2005.
- 2. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, Staff recommends that the Commission approve this Further Amendment prospectively. The Commission's review of the amendment is pursuant to 47 U.S.C. 252 (e), which provides that the Commission may reject an agreement if it finds that the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. The Staff states that the Further Amendment does not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not party to the agreement and is not against the public interest, convenience or necessity, and thus recommends approval of the Further Amendment.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission approve this Further Amendment prospectively and direct the parties to submit any modifications or amendments.
