
On May 3, 2013, the Commission issued an order that required any party wishing to reply to Complainants' and Staff's responses to AT&T Missouri's motion to dismiss do so no later than May 9. On May 6, AT&T Missouri filed a motion asking that the reply date be extended until May 20. That motion represents that neither Complainants nor the Commission's Staff oppose the proposed extension of time to reply. The Commission will grant the requested extension.
