MOTION TO AMEND ORDER ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT") and, for its Motion to Amend Order Adopting Procedural Schedule, states as follows:

1. On June 7, 2002, the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued its Order Adopting Procedural Schedule. In that Order, the Commission set the above-captioned matters for hearing on September 3, 2002, and September 24, 2002.

2. Two of SWBT's witnesses are not available on September 3, 2002. SWBT's attorney, therefore, contacted Judge Woodruff regarding other possible hearing dates. Judge Woodruff indicated that the Commission's Hearings Calendar was open September 24th, 25th, 26th, and 27th.

3. SWBT's attorney contacted counsel for Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, the Office of Public Counsel, AT&T of the Southwest, Inc., Brooks Fiber Communications of Missouri, Inc., MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc., and MCI

WorldCom Communications, Inc. All parties are available for hearing on September 24th and 25th.

4. SWBT respectfully requests that the Commission amend its Order Adopting Procedural Schedule and set the hearing for September 24th and 25th.¹

5. SWBT additionally requests that the Commission modify its Order Adopting Procedural Schedule to change the filing date for Surrebuttal Testimony to August 23, 2002, and the date for filing Statements of Positions to September 6, 2002.

WHEREFORE Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a Southwestern Bell Telephone Company prays the Commission grants its Motion to Amend Order Adopting Procedural Schedule, together with any further and/or additional relief the Commission deems just and proper.
