
The Commission's Staff has been conducting an ongoing investigation of call routing and completion problems in Missouri. As part of that investigation, Staff has collected comments from interested stakeholders. On May 31, 2013, Staff filed a request for comment regarding a recently passed legislative bill that would modify the authority of the Commission to regulate telecommunications companies. Staff asks whether the bill, if signed by the Governor, would alter stakeholder's previously expressed opinions about the Commission's authority to address call routing and completion problems. The Commission will offer interested stakeholders an opportunity to respond to Staff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any stakeholder wishing to respond to Staff's request for comment shall do so no later than June 14, 2013.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to all telecommunications companies certificated or otherwise registered to provide telecommunications service in Missouri.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
