## **SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE AND RATES**

## 3.1 General

JATO DSL services are non-switched, local exchange technologies that allow multiple forms of data and video to be carried over standard twisted pair coppers, or UNEs, on the local loop between the central office and the end user site.

JATO DSL services do not include access to/from the Public Switched Network (PSN). JATO DSL services provide data connections only and does not assign or otherwise route traffic by use of the telephone numbers, i.e. NPA-NXX-XXXX.

In the event that JATO begins to provide service to/from the PSN, JATO will file tariffs reflecting the rates, terms and conditions for such services.

JATO DSL (Digital Subscriber Line) services utilize technology over metallic local loop facilities to provide Customers with high-speed data services which utilize the twisted pair copper lines procured from the LEC in the form of unbundled network elements.
