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SECTION 1 - RULES AND REGULATIONS

1.1 Undertaking of AmericaNetworks, Inc.

AmericaNetworks, Inc. services and facilities are furnished for communications originating within the state of Missouri under the terms of this tariff. This tariff applies to both business and residential customers.

1.2. <u>Limitation</u>

- 1.2.1. Service is offered subject to the availability of the necessary facilities and equipment, or both facilities and equipment, and subject to the provisions of this tariff.
- 1.2.2. The Company reserves the right to discontinue or limit service upon written notice when the customer is using the service in violation of provisions of this tariff, or in violation of the law.
- 1.2.3. The services provided under this tariff are directly or indirectly controlled by AmericaNetworks, Inc. and the customer may not alter or affect the services nor transfer or assign its use of the services.
- 1.2.4. In the event prior written permission from the Company is given for any assignment or transfer, all regulations and conditions contained in this tariff shall apply to all such permitted assignees or transferees.

1.3. <u>Liabilities of the Company</u>

1.3.1. The Company has no liability for damages arising out of mistakes, interruptions, omissions, delays, errors, or defects in the transmission occurring in the course of furnishing service or facilities. The Company's liability for such damages occurring in the course of furnishing the Company's services but not caused by its gross negligence or willful misconduct or that of its employees or agents, in no event shall exceed an amount equivalent to the proportionate charge to the customer for the customer for the period during which such mistakes, interruption, omissions, delays, errors, or defects in the Company's furnishing of its services occur.

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
